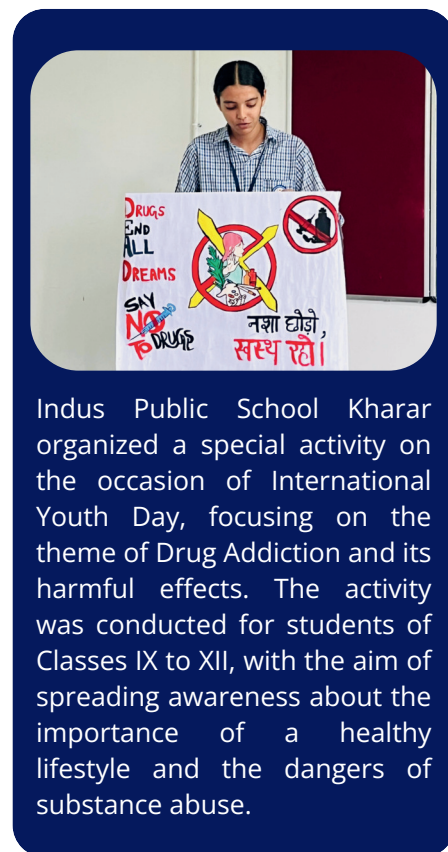
Janmashtami Celebration
